During the 2021/22 season, the Hewitt Cup will be run again as an internal club competition with a single league and an "all play all" format

Rate of play shall be 75min +5sec per move (or shorter by agreement ... but not less than 30min each)

Full length Hewitt games can be played OTB on clubnights

EXCEPT for Thursday nights and by mutual consent, Hewitt games can be played on-line at any time

Hewitt games will be ungraded

Normal rules of chess apply to the conduct of games; quick-play rules e.g. taking a king left in check, do **not** apply.

Results must be notified to me (Charles) as soon as possible by both players (if you want any points!)

Four points will be awarded for a win, two points for a draw, one for a loss ... easier than 1, 0.5 and 0.25 !

At the end of the competition (results **REPORTED** to me by **Friday 2nd September**) the person with the most points wins the Hewitt Cup

At the end of the competition the person with the next highest score (unless they have played more than twice for the first team) wins the Leyn Cup
